CONGRATULATING Pope Leo XIV upon his election as the first American Pope and extending best wishes for his spiritual leadership and global ministry as the leader of the Catholic Church

WHEREAS, His election has been met with great joy and hope by Catholics and non-Catholics alike, who look forward to his leadership in confronting the challenges of the modern world with faith, courage, and a renewed spirit of unity; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body to honor and celebrate historic and inspiring moments in the life of the global community, and to commend those whose lives are dedicated to uplifting others through faith and example; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to congratulate Pope Leo XIV upon his election as the first American Pope and to extend sincere best wishes for a fruitful and inspiring pontificate; and be it further
