AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to deeming certain nominating or designating petitions to be permeated with fraud and invalidating the filings made by a contested candidate

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 16-102 of the election law is amended by adding a
- 2 new subdivision 5 to read as follows:
- 3 5. Where the court has determined that a cumulative total of twenty-
- 4 five percent or more of all signatures on a petition are fraudulent, the
- 5 court shall issue a final order declaring the entire petition invalid
- 6 and permeated with fraud.
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
