AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, the New York city civil court act,  
and the uniform city court act, in relation to increasing the salaries  
of judges

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 221 of the judiciary law, as added by chapter 630  
2 of the laws of 1998, is amended to read as follows:

3 § 221. Salary of judges of the court of appeals. The annual salaries  
4 of the chief judge and associate judges of the court of appeals shall be  
5 as follows:

6 Chief Judge [~~156,000~~] 271,000

7 Associate Judge [~~151,200~~] 262,700

 4 appellate term in the manner provided in section eight of article six of  
 5 the constitution shall receive, in addition to [~~his or her~~] their judi-  
 6 cial salary as established by law, the sum of [~~three~~] five thousand four  
 7 hundred dollars annually as compensation for [~~his or her~~] their services  
 8 in appellate term. The presiding justice shall receive, in addition to  
 9 all other compensation, including for their services in the appellate  
 10 term, the sum of five thousand two hundred dollars annually as compen-  
 11 sation for their services as a presiding justice.
