AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to providing a right to representation by counsel for certain actions of the parole board

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 259-u
2 to read as follows:

3 § 259-u. Right to representation by counsel. In any proceeding where
4 an incarcerated individual is under consideration for release on parole
5 under the provisions of this article and where such incarcerated indi-
6 vidual is financially unable to retain counsel, the criminal court of
7 the city of New York, the county court or district court in the county
8 where the facility holding such incarcerated individual is located or
9 where the proceeding is held, shall assign counsel in accordance with
10 the county or city plan for representation placed in operation pursuant
11 to article eighteen-B of the county law.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of March next succeeding
13 the date on which it shall have become a law.
