AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to requiring emergency notices be provided to customers in certain languages

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The section heading of section 44 of the public service  
2 law, as added by chapter 713 of the laws of 1981, is amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 Utility bills[+] and informational notices.

5 § 2. Section 44 of the public service law is amended by adding a new  
6 subdivision 8 to read as follows:

7 8. (a) The commission shall require every utility corporation or muni-  
8 cipality who sends an emergency notice to its customers to make avail-  
9 able and provide such emergency notice in English and any other prevail-  
10 ing language as the commission deems necessary which shall include, but  
11 not be limited to, Spanish, Haitian-Creole, Mandarin, Cantonese, Arabic,  
12 French, Urdu, Russian, Yiddish, Korean, Bangla, Polish, Italian, Hindi  
13 and Tagalog.

14 (b) These emergency notices shall be available and provided in a paper  
15 format or transmitted electronically through call, text, and/or email.

16 (c) For the purposes of this subdivision, "emergency notices" shall  
17 include termination notices, outage notices, and any work notices that  
18 would impact services.

19 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
