AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to making a city school district in a city having a population of one million or more eligible for transitional aid for charter school payments

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 41 of section 3602 of
2 the education law, as amended by section 10-d of part A of chapter 56 of
3 the laws of 2025, is amended to read as follows:

4 In addition to any other apportionment under this section, for the two
5 thousand seven--two thousand eight school year and thereafter, a school
6 district [~~other than a city school district in a city having a popu-~~
7 ~~lation of one million or more~~] shall be eligible for an apportionment in
8 an amount equal to the greater of the sum of paragraphs (a), (b), and
9 (c), or paragraph (e) of this subdivision.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2027; provided, however, if
11 this act shall have become a law after such date it shall take effect
12 immediately and shall be deemed to have been in full force and effect on
13 and after April 1, 2027.
