AN ACT directing the commissioner of corrections and community supervision to study gender disparity in resources provided to incarcerated individuals

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The commissioner of corrections and community supervision
2 is authorized and directed to study gender disparity in resources
3 provided to incarcerated individuals. Such study shall include, but not
4 be limited to:
- 5 (a) what resources are made available to incarcerated individuals;
 - 6 (b) the amount of such resources made available to incarcerated indi-
7 viduals of each gender;
 - 8 (c) the reasons for any disparities found between the amount of
9 resources made available to incarcerated individuals of each gender;
 - 10 (d) recommendations on actions that may be taken to resolve any
11 disparities found between the amount of resources made available to
12 incarcerated individuals of each gender; and
 - 13 (e) any other related information that the commissioner may deem
14 necessary or relevant in carrying out this study.
- 15 § 2. The commissioner of corrections and community supervision shall
16 make a report to the governor and the legislature of the findings,
17 conclusions and recommendations no later than one year after the effec-
18 tive date of this act and shall submit with this report such legislative
19 proposals as they deem necessary to implement their recommendations.
- 20 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
