AN ACT to amend the arts and cultural affairs law, in relation to authorizing the council on the arts to designate Little Yemen as a cultural district

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 3.05 of the arts and cultural
2 affairs law, as added by chapter 677 of the laws of 2024, is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 11. To promote regions of cultural significance by providing cultural
5 institutions within such regions grants, technical assistance, or other
6 assistance authorized by this section as the council deems appropriate,
7 including, but not limited to~~[-]~~: (a) East Harlem, also known as "El
8 Barrio". This region shall be bounded by East 96th Street on the South,
9 5th Avenue on the West, East 125th Street on the North and the East
10 River on the East; and (b) "Little Yemen". This region shall be bounded
11 by White Plains Road on the South, Bronxdale Avenue on the North, Morris
12 Park Avenue on the West, and Van Nest Avenue on the East. The council
13 may designate additional regions of cultural significance at its
14 discretion but such regions shall be compact, contiguous, and have an
15 identifiable cultural heritage which unites the region.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
