AN ACT to amend the religious corporations law, in relation to the court approval process for the sale, mortgage and lease of real property of a religious corporation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (d-1) of subdivision 1 of section 2-b of the
2 religious corporations law, as amended by chapter 193 of the laws of
3 1985, is amended to read as follows:

4 (d-1) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter or the not-for-
5 profit corporation law, any church referred to in subdivision two,
6 three, four, five, five-a, five-b, five-c, **five-d** or six of section
7 twelve of this chapter shall not be required to give notice to the
8 attorney general of any application required by subdivision one of
9 section twelve of this chapter or any application or petition required
10 under section five hundred ten or section five hundred eleven of the
11 not-for-profit corporation law.

12 § 2. Section 12 of the religious corporations law is amended by adding
13 a new subdivision 5-d to read as follows:

14 **5-d. The trustees of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America shall**
15 **not make application to the court for leave to mortgage, lease or sell**
16 **any of its real property without the consent of its archbishop.**

17 § 3. Subdivision 6 of section 12 of the religious corporations law, as
18 amended by chapter 381 of the laws of 1985, is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 6. The petition of the trustees of an incorporated Protestant Episco-
21 pal church or Roman Catholic church shall, in addition to the matters
22 required by article five of the not-for-profit corporation law to be set
23 forth therein, set forth that this section has also been complied with.

EXPLANATION--Matter in **italics** (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 The petition of the trustees of an incorporated African Methodist Epis-
2 copal Zion church shall in addition to the matters required by article
3 five of the not-for-profit corporation law to be set forth therein, set
4 forth that this section has also been complied with. The petition of the
5 trustees of an incorporated Presbyterian church in connection with the
6 General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), shall, in addition
7 to the matters required by article five of the not-for-profit corpo-
8 ration law to be set forth therein, set forth that this section has also
9 been complied with. The petition of the trustees of an incorporated
10 United Methodist church shall, in addition to the matters required by
11 article five of the not-for-profit corporation law to be set forth ther-
12 ein, set forth that this section has also been complied with. The peti-
13 tion of the trustees of an incorporated Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of
14 America church shall, in addition to the matters required by article
15 five of the not-for-profit corporation law to be set forth therein, set
16 forth that this section has also been complied with.

17 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
