AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the parks, recreation and historic preservation law, in relation to vintage snowmobile registrations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4-a of section 2222 of the vehicle and traffic  
2 law, as amended by section 1 of part MM of chapter 58 of the laws of  
3 2023, is amended to read as follows:  
4 4-a. Additional fee. (a) In addition to the other fees provided for in  
5 paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of subdivision four of this section the  
6 commissioner shall, upon application in such cases for the registration  
7 of a snowmobile or the renewal thereof, collect the annual one hundred  
8 twenty-five dollar fee for residents and one hundred twenty-five dollar  
9 fee for nonresidents or a fifty-five dollar fee for residents and  
10 fifty-five dollar fee for nonresidents who provide proof, at the time of  
11 registration, that such individual is a member of an organized New York  
12 state snowmobile club that is a member of the New York state snowmobile  
13 association or is a member of an organized New York state snowmobile  
14 club that is a trail maintenance entity and a member of the New York  
15 state snowmobile association which are imposed by section 21.07 of the  
16 parks, recreation and historic preservation law. In the event that an  
17 individual seeking snowmobile club membership is unable, for any reason,  
18 to secure such club membership, [~~he or she~~] such individual may contact  
19 the New York state snowmobile association, who shall secure such member-  
20 ship for such person. This fee shall also be collected from dealers at  
21 the time of original registration and at the time of each renewal. The  
22 commissioner shall effectuate regulations regarding what is required as  
23 proof of membership in an organized New York state snowmobile club that

1 is a trail maintenance entity and a member of the New York state snowmo-  
2 bile association for the purposes of this subdivision.

3 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the commis-  
4 sioner is hereby authorized and directed to develop and issue to appli-  
5 cants a special vintage registration for a snowmobile that is more than  
6 thirty years old. Such vintage registration shall be identifiable by a  
7 vintage registration sticker, have a unique registration number and be  
8 subject to annual renewal. In addition to the fees collected pursuant to  
9 paragraph (f) of subdivision four of this section, the commissioner  
10 shall collect an annual fee of twenty dollars for a resident and non-re-  
11 sident applicant who provides proof, at the time of registration, that  
12 such individual is a member of an organized New York state snowmobile  
13 club that is a member of the New York state snowmobile association or is  
14 a member of an organized New York state snowmobile club that is a trail  
15 maintenance entity and a member of the New York state snowmobile associ-  
16 ation. The commissioner may provide that applications for a vintage  
17 snowmobile registration and the issuing of a vintage snowmobile regis-  
18 tration may only be accepted and processed at one or more facilities  
19 operated by the department either by mail or in person.

20 § 2. Subdivision 4 of section 2222 of the vehicle and traffic law is  
21 amended by adding a new paragraph (f) to read as follows:

22 (f) A fee of five dollars for each individual resident and non-resi-  
23 dent vintage registration.

24 § 3. Section 21.07 of the parks, recreation and historic preservation  
25 law is amended by adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:

26 3. Notwithstanding the fee established in subdivisions one and two of  
27 this section, an individual resident or nonresident registering a  
28 vintage snowmobile who provides proof at the time of registration that  
29 such individual is a member of an organized New York state snowmobile  
30 club that is a member of the New York state snowmobile association or is  
31 a member of an organized New York state snowmobile club that is a trail  
32 maintenance entity and a member of the New York state snowmobile associ-  
33 ation, shall pay an additional fee of twenty dollars for each vintage  
34 snowmobile for the snowmobile trail development and maintenance fund in  
35 addition to the registration required by the vehicle and traffic law. In  
36 the event that an individual seeking snowmobile club membership is  
37 unable, for any reason, to secure such club membership, such individual  
38 may contact the New York state snowmobile association, who shall secure  
39 such membership for such person.

40 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, a  
41 special vintage registration for a snowmobile may not be issued until  
42 the commissioner of the department of motor vehicles certifies that the  
43 department is prepared to issue special vintage registrations for snow-  
44 mobiles.
