Introduced by Sen. HELMING -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Civil Service and Pensions

AN ACT in relation to authorizing Heath A. Wadhams to take the competitive civil service examination for the position of police officer and be placed on the eligible list for employment as a full-time police officer for the village of Palmyra

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 58 of the civil
2 service law, including the age requirements under paragraph (a) of
3 subdivision 1 of such section, or any other provision of law to the
4 contrary, Heath A. Wadhams, who has been continuously employed by the
5 village of Palmyra, in the county of Wayne, as a part-time police offi-
6 cer, shall be eligible to take the competitive civil service examination
7 for the position of police officer and shall, contingent upon his score
8 on such examination, be eligible to be placed on the eligible list for
9 appointment as a full-time police officer with the village of Palmyra
10 police department.

11 § 2. Heath A. Wadhams shall otherwise be subject to the merit and
12 fitness provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time
13 police officers.

14 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
