AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to prohibiting transcripts being made from video conference meetings by artificial intelligence without conspicuous disclosure during such meeting

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The civil rights law is amended by adding a new section  
2 50-h to read as follows:

3 § 50-h. Right to privacy; transcription. No person shall permit a  
4 video conference meeting to be transcribed by artificial intelligence  
5 without such meeting having a conspicuous disclosure during such meeting  
6 that every person who attended such meeting may have their words from  
7 such meeting transcribed by artificial intelligence.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall  
9 have become a law.
