AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to changing party enrollment of voters where the enrolled party contained the word "Independence" or "Independent"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The election law is amended by adding a new section 5-312
2 to read as follows:

3 § 5-312. Enrollment; unenrollment from certain parties. Any person
4 enrolled in a party which includes the words "Independence" or "Inde-
5 pendent" shall have their voter enrollment changed such that they are
6 not enrolled in any party.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
