AN ACT to amend the public buildings law, in relation to prohibiting the use of adhesive-based rodent traps in state-owned or state-leased buildings

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public buildings law is amended by adding a new section 148 to read as follows:

§ 148. Adhesive-based rodent traps; prohibition. 1. As used in this section the following terms shall have the following meanings:

(a) "adhesive-based rodent trap" shall mean any device that is designed or is capable of being used to capture a rodent by means of an adhesive substance, including devices commonly known as glue traps, glue boards, and any similar rodent trap.

(b) "state-owned building" shall have the same meaning as provided in section one hundred forty-five of this article.

(c) "state-leased building" shall have the same meaning as provided in section one hundred forty-five of this article.

2. The use of adhesive-based rodent traps shall be prohibited in state-owned or state-leased buildings.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2027 for state-owned buildings and for new leases or renewals for state-leased buildings entered into on or after such date.
