AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to imposing a  
supplemental registration fee for counties outside of the metropolitan  
commuter transportation district

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-  
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new  
2 article 17-D to read as follows:

### ARTICLE 17-D

#### SUPPLEMENTAL REGISTRATION FEE FOR COUNTIES OUTSIDE THE METROPOLITAN COMMUTER TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT

7 499-f. Upstate transit supplemental registration fee.

12 § 499-e. Definition. For the purposes of this article "upstate" shall  
13 mean the area of the state outside in the district created and governed  
14 by section twelve hundred sixty-two of the public authorities law.

15 § 499-f. Upstate transit supplemental registration fee. Registrants  
16 residing in counties outside the metropolitan commuter transportation  
17 district shall upon the registration or renewal of a motor vehicle be  
18 charged a supplemental registration fee to be paid to the commissioner  
19 or such commissioner's agent in accordance with the provisions of this  
20 article.

21 § 499-g. Collection of supplemental fee. All registrants of motor  
22 vehicles who reside outside the metropolitan commuter transportation  
23 district shall pay to the commissioner or such commissioner's agent the  
24 supplemental registration fee provided for in this article upon regis-  
25 tration or renewal of motor vehicles subject to registration fees pursu-  
26 ant to the following sections of this title: paragraph a of subdivision  
27 six of section four hundred one of this title; schedules A, B, C, E, F,

1 G, I and K of subdivision seven of section four hundred one of this  
2 title; paragraph a of subdivision eight of section four hundred one of  
3 this title; paragraph a of subdivision five of section four hundred ten  
4 of this title; and section four hundred eleven-b of this title.

5 § 499-h. Calculation of supplemental registration fee. The supple-  
6 mental registration fee to be charged pursuant to section four hundred  
7 ninety-nine-f of this article, shall be calculated at a rate of twenty-  
8 five dollars per annum for each year or portion of a year that such  
9 registration is valid.

10 § 499-i. Deposit and disposition of revenue from the upstate transit  
11 supplemental fee. The commissioner shall deposit daily all funds  
12 collected pursuant to this article with responsible banks, banking hous-  
13 es and trust companies as designated by the state comptroller, in trust  
14 for credit of the public transportation systems operating assistance  
15 account established by section eighty-eight-a of the state finance law.  
16 Such deposits shall be kept separate and apart from all other money in  
17 the possession of the comptroller. On or before the twelfth day of each  
18 month, the commissioner shall certify to the comptroller the amount of  
19 all revenues received pursuant to this paragraph during the prior month  
20 as a result of the supplemental fees imposed, including any interest and  
21 penalties thereon. The revenues so certified over the prior three months  
22 in total shall be paid over by the fifteenth day of the last month of  
23 each calendar quarter from such account, without appropriation, into the  
24 public transportation systems operating assistance account established  
25 by section eighty-eight-a of the state finance law.

26 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
