AN ACT to amend vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting metered parking on certain streets in the city of New York

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
2 section 1640-t to read as follows:
3 § 1640-t. Residential parking in the city of New York. 1. For the
4 purposes of this section, the term "residential dwelling" shall mean any
5 building or structure used in whole or in part as the home residence or
6 sleeping place of one or more humans excluding mixed use property where
7 primary ground floor use is commercial.
8 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, the city
9 of New York shall be prohibited from placing parking meters on streets
10 that contain no less than fifty percent and no more than seventy-five
11 percent of buildings that qualify as residential dwellings.
12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
