AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to authorizing domestic violence shelters to be reimbursed for housing a single individual in a room intended for double occupancy

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 131-u of the social services law is amended by adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:

3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a residential program for victims of domestic violence, as defined in section four hundred fifty-nine-a of this chapter, which provides temporary housing assistance to a single individual who meets such program's necessary eligibility requirements, shall be reimbursed for the payment differential, if any, for housing a single individual in a room intended for double occupancy, if no other room intended for single occupancy is available within the facility in accordance with the following:

(a) for the fiscal year beginning April first, two thousand twenty-six the reimbursement shall be twenty-five percent of any cost differential;

(b) for the fiscal year beginning April first, two thousand twenty-seven the reimbursement shall be fifty percent of any cost differential;

(c) for the fiscal year beginning April first, two thousand twenty-eight the reimbursement shall be seventy-five percent of any cost differential; and

(d) for the fiscal year beginning April first, two thousand twenty-nine the reimbursement shall be one hundred percent of any cost differential.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
