AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring state agencies to develop plans for new Americans

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 94-b of the executive law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

3 6. State agency plans. Each state agency shall develop a plan for new
4 Americans that incorporates effective training and resources, ensures
5 culturally and linguistically competent and appropriate services, and
6 includes administrative practices that reach out to and reflect the
7 needs of immigrant populations and populations with limited English
8 proficiency. Each state agency shall consider the recommendations of the
9 office for new Americans when creating the agency's plans and shall
10 submit such plans to the governor for approval.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
