Introduced by M. of A. FORREST -- read once and referred to the Committee on Insurance

AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to prohibiting discrimination through the use of clinical algorithms

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 3243-a
2 to read as follows:

3 § 3243-a. Discrimination through use of clinical algorithms. (a) An
4 insurer subject to this article shall not discriminate on the basis of
5 race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability through the use of
6 clinical algorithms in its decision-making.

7 (b) This section shall not prohibit the use of clinical algorithms
8 that rely on variables to appropriately make decisions, including to
9 identify, evaluate, and address health disparities.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
