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Introduced by M. of A. DILAN -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to create a temporary state commission to study and make recommendations concerning the incidence of asthma in the borough of Brooklyn in New York city

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. A temporary state commission is hereby created to study and  
2 make recommendations relating to the incidence of asthma in the borough  
3 of Brooklyn in New York city. The commission will place particular  
4 emphasis on youth in communities with an unemployment rate exceeding one  
5 hundred twenty-five percent of the statewide level.

6 § 2. The commission shall consist of eleven members to be appointed as  
7 follows: five shall be appointed by the governor; two shall be appointed  
8 by the temporary president of the senate and one by the minority leader  
9 of the senate; and two shall be appointed by the speaker of the assembly  
10 and one by the minority leader of the assembly. The members of the  
11 commission shall serve at the pleasure of the official making the  
12 appointment of such member. Of the five members appointed by the gover-  
13 nor, one shall be from the department of health and one shall be from  
14 the department of environmental conservation. The remaining nine members  
15 of the commission must reside in a city with a population of one million  
16 or more. Vacancies in the membership of the commission shall be filled  
17 in the manner provided for original appointments. Membership on the  
18 commission shall not constitute a public office. A chairperson and vice-  
19 chairperson of the commission shall be elected by a majority of its  
20 members, all members being present.

21 § 3. The members of the commission shall receive no compensation for  
22 their services, but shall be allowed their actual and necessary expenses  
23 incurred in the performance of their duties pursuant to this act.

EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets  
[-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 § 4. The commission may meet within and without the state, shall hold  
2 at least one public hearing each quarter, and shall have all the powers  
3 of a legislative committee pursuant to the legislative law.

4 § 5. The commission shall make a report of its findings and make any  
5 recommendations it may deem necessary and appropriate to the governor,  
6 the temporary president of the senate and the speaker of the assembly no  
7 later than one year after the effective date of this act.

8 § 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
