AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to prohibiting students from possessing cellphones during classroom instruction

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 2801 of the education law, as amended by chapter 380 of the laws of 2001, is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 a. provisions regarding conduct, dress and language deemed appropriate
4 and acceptable on school property, including a school function, and
5 conduct, dress and language deemed unacceptable and inappropriate on
6 school property, including a school function, and provisions regarding
7 acceptable civil and respectful treatment of teachers
