Introduced by M. of A. SLATER -- read once and referred to the Committee on Election Law

AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring persons appointed as election commissioners to be citizens of the United States

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 3-200 of the election law, as
2 amended by chapter 195 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as
3 follows:
4 4. No person shall be appointed as election commissioner or continue
5 to hold office who is not a registered voter in the county [~~and~~], not an
6 enrolled member of the party recommending [~~his~~] such person's appoint-
7 ment, not a citizen of the United States, or who holds any other public
8 office, except that of commissioner of deeds, notary public, village
9 officer, city or town justice, member of a community board within the
10 city of New York or trustee or officer of a school district outside of a
11 city.
12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
