AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to enacting Vincent Scheppa's law authorizing, in certain cases, the provision of in-home private duty nursing services to a recipient of medical assistance by a relative who is a registered professional nurse

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Vincent
2 Scheppa's law".

3 § 2. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 365-q
4 to read as follows:

5 § 365-q. Provision of in-home private duty nursing services by the
6 relative of a recipient. Upon application or request to the commissioner
7 by a recipient of medical assistance, or their representative or guardi-
8 an, who has been approved for the provision of in-home private duty
9 nursing, the commissioner may authorize the provision of such private
10 duty nursing by an adult relative of such recipient, other than a spouse
11 of the recipient, who is a registered professional nurse. Reimbursement
12 for private nursing services provided in accordance with this section
13 shall be at the rate paid for the provision of such services by a
14 licensed practical nurse.

15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
