AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to prohibiting state-operated hospitals from suing patients for medical debt

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new article 51
2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 51

PROHIBITION ON STATE-OPERATED HOSPITALS SUING PATIENTS FOR MEDICAL DEBT

3 Section 5100. Prohibition on state-operated hospitals suing patients for

5 § 5100. Prohibition on state-operated hospitals suing patients for
6 medical debt. 1. No state university health care facility authorized
7 under article eight of the education law, cancer institute authorized
8 under article ten-C of the public authorities law, or hospital author-
9 ized under section twenty-six hundred of this chapter shall pursue liti-
10 gation in civil or supreme court against a patient for the pursuit of a
11 medical debt.

12 2. For the purposes of this section, the term "medical debt" shall
13 mean an obligation or alleged obligation of a consumer to pay any amount
14 related to the receipt of health care services, products, or devices
15 provided to a person by a hospital licensed under article twenty-eight
16 of this chapter, a health care professional authorized under title eight
17 of the education law or an ambulance service certified under article
18 thirty of this chapter.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
