AN ACT in relation to authorizing the assessor of the town of Brookhaven to accept an application for a real property tax exemption from Calvary Full Gospel Assembly of God Church

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, the assessor of the town of Brookhaven is hereby authorized to accept from the
2 Calvary Full Gospel Assembly of God Church an application for exemption
3 from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property
4 tax law with respect to the 2023-2024 assessment rolls for the parcel
5 owned by such organization located in the town of Brookhaven at 777 Sipp
6 Avenue in the hamlet of East Patchogue, also known as district 0200,
7 section 927.00, block 01.00, lot 023.005. If accepted, the application
8 shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable
9 status date established for such assessment rolls.

10 If satisfied that such corporation would otherwise be entitled to such
11 exemption if such corporation had filed an application for exemption by
12 the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor, upon approval of the
13 town of Brookhaven town board, may grant exemption from taxation on such
14 assessment rolls and make the appropriate corrections of the subject
15 rolls. If exemptions are granted and such corporation, therefore, shall
16 have paid any tax with respect to the subject rolls, the applicable
17 governing body or tax departments, in their sole discretion, shall
18 provide for the refund of the taxes paid, along with any fines or penalties paid, and cancel taxes remaining unpaid.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
