CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to article 4 of the constitution, in relation to the gubernatorial absence provision

1 Section 1. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That section 5 of article 4 of the constitution be amended as follows:

2 § 5. In case of the removal of the governor from office or of [~~his or~~
3 ~~her~~] the governor's death or resignation, the lieutenant-governor shall
4 become governor for the remainder of the term. In case the governor-elect
5 shall decline to serve or shall die, the lieutenant-governor-elect
6 shall become governor for the full term.

7 In case the governor is impeached[~~, is absent from the state~~] or is
8 [~~otherwise~~] unable to discharge the powers and duties of the office of
9 governor, the lieutenant-governor shall act as governor until the
10 inability shall cease or until the term of the governor shall expire.

11 In case of the failure of the governor-elect to take the oath of
12 office at the commencement of [~~his or her~~] such governor-elect's term,
13 the lieutenant-governor-elect shall act as governor until the [~~governor~~]
14 governor-elect shall take the oath.

15 § 2. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the third, fourth and
16 fifth undesignated paragraphs of section 6 of article 4 of the constitution
17 be amended as follows:

18 In case of vacancy in the offices of both governor and lieutenant-governor
19 or if both of them shall be impeached[~~, absent from the state~~] or
20 [~~otherwise~~] unable to discharge the powers and duties of the office of
21 governor, the temporary president of the senate shall act as governor
22 until the inability shall cease or until a governor shall be elected.

23 In case of vacancy in the office of lieutenant-governor alone, or if
24 the lieutenant-governor shall be impeached[~~, absent from the state~~] or
25 [~~otherwise~~] unable to discharge the powers and duties of office, the

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1 temporary president of the senate shall perform all the powers and
2 duties of lieutenant-governor during such vacancy or inability.

3 If, when the duty of acting as governor devolves upon the temporary
4 president of the senate, there be a vacancy in such office or the tempo-
5 rary president of the senate shall be [~~absent from the state or other-~~
6 ~~wise~~] unable to discharge the duties of governor, the speaker of the
7 assembly shall act as governor during such vacancy or inability.

8 § 3. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the foregoing amendment
9 be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the
10 next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in
11 conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be
12 published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
