AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to establishing minimum staffing levels for certain local board of elections

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3-300 of the election law is amended to read as follows:

§ 3-300. Board employees; appointment. 1. Every board of elections shall appoint, and at its pleasure remove, clerks, voting machine technicians, custodians and other employees, fix their number, prescribe their duties, fix their titles and rank and establish their salaries within the amounts appropriated therefor by the local legislative body and shall secure in the appointment of employees of the board of elections equal representation of the major political parties.

2. Every board of elections of a county that includes over ten thousand active registered voters shall employ, at a minimum, four full-time employees inclusive of any full-time commissioners and full-time deputies. Every board of elections shall employ two additional employees for every full allotment of twenty thousand active registered voters under its jurisdiction. Any board of elections below the minimum number of employees required by this subdivision shall hire two additional full-time employees annually until the minimum requirement is met, provided that the minimum requirement is met within three years of the effective date of this subdivision.

3. Every commissioner in each board of elections except for commissioners of the board of elections of the city of New York, may approve
