PROCEEDINGS 1 2 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: 3 The Senate will please come to order. 4 I ask everyone present to rise and 5 recite with me the Pledge of Allegiance to our б Flag. 7 (Whereupon, the assemblage recited 8 the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.) 9 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: 10 In the absence of clergy, may we all bow our heads for a moment of silence. 11 12 (Whereupon, the assemblage respected a moment of silence.) 13 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: 14 15 Thank you. Senator Smith. 16 SENATOR SMITH: Yes, Madam 17 18 President. Is there a proclamation from the Governor at the desk? 19 20 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: Yes, Senator Smith, there is a proclamation 21 22 here at the desk. 23 The Secretary will read. 24 THE SECRETARY: "Pursuant to the

power vested in me by Article IV, Section 3 of 1 the Constitution, I hereby convene the Senate 2 of the State of New York in Extraordinary 3 4 Session, at the Capitol, in the City of 5 Albany, on the sixth day of July, two thousand nine, at three o'clock p.m., for the purpose б of considering legislation I will submit with 7 8 respect to various subjects, and considering gubernatorial nominations. 9 10 "Given under my hand and the Privy Seal of the State in the City of Albany this 11 first day of July in the year two thousand 12 nine, by the Governor, David A. Paterson." 13 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: 14 15 The proclamation having been read, the Senate is in extraordinary session. 16 Senator Smith. 17 18 SENATOR SMITH: Yes, Madam President, would you please recognize my 19 20 colleague Senator Dean Skelos. ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: 21 Senator Skelos. 22 23 SENATOR SKELOS: Thank you. 24 Good afternoon, Senator

Stewart-Cousins. 1 2 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: 3 Good afternoon. 4 SENATOR SKELOS: At the 5 Governor's request, and in keeping with the decision of the court, we convene this 6 7 extraordinary session. 8 As I've stated before, the designation of a presiding officer should be 9 10 made by Senator Espada or myself pursuant to the votes which took place on June 8th. 11 12 Accordingly, we do not recognize that you are the appropriately designated presiding 13 officer. 14 15 Therefore, I'd request that the agenda be laid aside and move that the Senate 16 adjourn this special session sine die. 17 18 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: Thank you, Senator Skelos. 19 20 Senator Smith. SENATOR SMITH: 21 Yes, thank you, 22 Madam President. So good to see you this 23 afternoon. 24 Before we move on this day, I would

1	like to at least acknowledge the fact that
2	today a lot of our Fellows, who have served
3	the Senate very well on both sides of the
4	aisle, are here today. Some of them have
5	moved on, some will be moving on, some are
6	still here at the Senate.
7	They have had obviously an
8	extraordinary experience this year. It is one
9	that provides them with the ability to learn
10	not only what state government is about, but
11	also to see how the inner workings of one of
12	the most distinguished bodies in this country
13	performs.
14	I do want to acknowledge some of
15	those who are here and who they've worked for.
16	We had Matthew Gass, who worked in our press
17	office. We had Sara Bangs, who worked in
18	Majority Counsel. We had Linda Cohen, who
19	worked for Senator Bill Perkins.
20	We had Katherine Milcarek-Burke,
21	who I believe might be still in her office.
22	Justin Giffuni, who worked for Senator
23	Marcellino. We had Dilay Watson, who worked
24	for Senator Sampson. Martin McGuinness, who I

don't think is here right now. 1 We also had Burton Phillips, who 2 worked for Senator Maziarz; Catherine Price, 3 who I believe is still in the office; 4 5 Elizabeth Navran; Jane Tsamardinos, who actually worked for Senator Hannon -- I think 6 7 Senator Hannon is here also -- Gregory Myers 8 and Ryan Spelman. 9 We just want to say congratulations 10 to you for doing a great job. We're looking forward to your continued service in 11 12 government. It is a great place to be; it's a noble profession. 13 14 (Applause.) 15 SENATOR SMITH: Now, Madam President, would you please recognize Senator 16 17 Hassell-Thompson for an announcement. 18 ACTING PRESIDENT STEWART-COUSINS: Senator Hassell-Thompson. 19 20 SENATOR HASSELL-THOMPSON: Yes, thank you, Madam President. 21 22 Immediately following session, 23 there will be a meeting of the Majority in the 24 Majority Conference Room, 332.
