Legislatively, it will improve our 12 powers to deliver upon the promises that we 13 made to the constituents that we serve --14 15 19.5 million people have watched us at our

A few years ago Senator Little had 16 a bill very similar to this. Senator Little's 17 18 bill had a sunset provision in that legislation that became law. It allowed us to 19 20 take a look at how certain parts of the state 21 had needs for veterinarians, but we didn't 22 collapse and abolish citizenship regulations. 23 This bill puts out, for 24 veterinarians as a profession, makes them

different than many other professions that 1 still have citizenship requirements. 2 bill really should have a sunset provision for 3 4 the reasons that Senator DeFrancisco 5 articulated, because we need to fill this void -- if there is one in certain parts of 6 7 the state -- with our own students, with our 8 own citizens. 9 I vote no. 10 ACTING PRESIDENT VALESKY: Senator LaValle to be recorded in the 11 12 negative. Senator Stavisky, to explain her 13 14 vote. 15 SENATOR STAVISKY: Yes, Mr. President. I vote yes because of the 16 serious shortage of veterinarians in upstate 17 18 New York. Particularly significant because of its proximity to the Canadian border, it makes 19 20 it a lot easier to attract veterinarians. It's interesting that other parts 21 22 of the state are also experiencing shortages. 23 For example, in the Buffalo-Niagara Frontier area, there are only two students at the 24

College of Veterinarian Medicine at Cornell 1 2 from this area, only two students. 3 So to overcome these problems --4 and there are similar shortages, incidentally, 5 of students in the Capital District, in the Rochester area, and in the Hudson Valley. Mr. President. I would like to note that the record should reflect that the clock has struck midnight. And I move, pursuant to Rule 5, that the Senate remains in session so that we may complete our work.

Mr. President, though, prior to us completing our work, I would like to read a statement that Senator John Sampson, Senator Pedro Espada, Senator Dean Skelos, Senator Jeff Klein and myself have put out in the spirit of what we're looking to do with regard to reforming the State Senate. And it reads as follows:

"We, as leaders of our respective conferences, have agreed on a framework for historic rules reform that will help us move forward to improve the operation of the State Senate. The reforms encompass many of the recommendations of the Senate Temporary Committee on Rules and Reform that was chaired by Senator Bonacic and chaired by Senator Valesky, as reported on April 21st, as well as

some of the reforms that were advanced on

June 8th and we believe will create a more

open and bipartisan member-driven body.

"These reforms are long overdue.

They give each individual Senator the means of effectively representing their constituents and assure each Senator will be treated fairly with respect to the way they do their jobs to the best of their ability.

"We believe these rules will empower all 62 members of this body. It will give greater opportunity to get bills moved out of committee and onto the floor for a vote," Senator Squadron.

"There will be greater public notification of bills on committee agendas, greater notice on the active list. We will compete with C-SPAN by having our own network in which we will look to have ourselves televised beyond the immediate conditions.

"We also have agreed that the Senate administration will be fair and nonpartisan, including access to services such as printing, mailing, and providing equitable

allocation for staff.

"We hope the conference will use these reforms, and we hope that we'll be taking these up as soon as next week. But more importantly, we believe by enacting these reforms we hope that the Senate will be a more effective body and will serve the people of the State of New York."

Mr. President, we think this is a time for more bipartisanship than this body has ever had. We think we have a responsibility to not only the 19.5 million people -- as our conference leader, Senator John Sampson, so ably says so many times -- but we believe this is an opportunity for us to restore the faith, trust and hope of the people of the State of New York in this body, which is one of and still is one of the most esteemed bodies in this country. We will continue to perform our duty as we continue to move forward on this calendar.

So with that, Mr. President, I ask that we return to the noncontroversial calendar and continue to read.

ACTING PRESIDENT VALESKY:

2 Senator Skelos.

SENATOR SKELOS: If I could follow up on the comments made by Senator Malcolm Smith.

I believe that sometimes the outside world and perhaps even the media wonders what happened in the past month. We are on the verge, and I believe with the support of the Majority, of really reforming the way this Senate chamber operates in the future.

We've been involved in a month-long struggle, but I also believe that the end result, as committed to by Senator Malcolm Smith and Senator John Sampson, is that we will be enacting historic reforms to change the way the process works here and also open up to the sunlight, to all of our constituents and the media, to see exactly how the process works and how we function.

It's also going to empower the individual members. I know that this is something that has been extremely important to

Senator Bonacic, who was a cochair of the committee, Senator Winner and Senator Griffo, and in fact every single member of our conference.

It's my hope that in the next several days, the reforms -- and I appreciate your reading that statement -- that we felt could have and should have been passed tonight will be enacted when we return next week.

I think it's also important to note that, as I've said in the past, perhaps the dramatic steps that were taken on June 8th is also an indication to the public not just that reforms are critically important, but the direction this state was going -- in overspending, overtaxing, payroll taxes, antibusiness, antijob, elimination of STAR rebate checks -- cannot continue in the future.

And that's our commitment to the public. I think we've made that statement clear and strong. And certainly I look forward to working with you, Senator Smith, to enact the reforms.

And it's also my hope that the 1 2 collegiality that we should have within the 3 Senate, and the open and frank discussions and 4 debates, will continue perhaps in a more 5 toned-down way. 6 So again, I appreciate, Senator 7 Smith, your reading that statement. And 8 certainly it's my desire, my hope, and I take you at your word and Senator Sampson at his 9 10 word that these critical reforms which we started on June 8th will become part of the 11 rules of the Senate next week when we 12 13 reconvene. County.

We need to improve those parks so they can enjoy, let's say, the full measure of what Suffolk has to offer. This particular resolution will enable the county to improve those parks and, in so doing, improve the park experience that many families come to our county to enjoy.

So those are some of the reasons why we have strong support for this resolution by both sides of the aisle in the county legislature in Suffolk County.

This bill indicates that monies

should know is that members of the Long Island
delegation have worked for many years to
secure funding for the police to patrol the
Long Island Expressway and the Sunrise

Highway.

I was offering an amendment, but what my amendment was trying to do was to say that the money received by such fund shall be expended directly to the counties of Suffolk and Nassau to provide funding for the cost of staffing the patrol units for the Long Island Expressway and the Sunrise Highway in both Suffolk and Nassau, and also allow for those municipalities outside of the police district only in the County of Suffolk on a proportional basis to receive some monies to patrol the state highways.

I guess what I am talking about is -- and I think a lot of members in the Assembly voted against this bill because it's, again, some hope that the appropriation will

1 be there in the future.

So I am not going to support this bill, because I believe that the monies should go directly to both counties that this bill intends to help. And I believe if the language in the bill said that, I would be supporting it, because it's a goal that we in both Nassau and Suffolk Counties have sought, to have proper patrolling of the highways.

So when the bill comes up for a vote, Mr. President, I am going to vote in the negative.

And I know there are those who will say, well, this is the type of bill you don't really need one. But we get caught in this situation all the time where we have purportedly these requests coming from counties. If they want it, they should be sending us a home-rule message saying they want it.

Because what they're going to do, ladies and gentlemen -- you all know this -- this bill is going to pass, they're going to enact something locally, and then they're going to turn around and tell everybody, hey, the State of New York passed a law. They're going to blame us. They're going to blame us. That's number one.

Number two, Senator LaValle is absolutely right. The provisions in this bill make no guarantee whatsoever in any way, shape or form that this money is actually going to go to the place that it's intended. This money can be kept by the State of New York, it's a special fund set up by the Comptroller, the Governor can take this money right away.

So there's no guarantee that it's supposed to get to the place that it was originally intended to go.

On top of that, there's no sunset.

There's no sunset in here. It's a

permanentizing something that is going to cost

people more money.

And finally, I do believe we are getting to the point where we need to take a serious look at the taxes and fees more so than we are doing right now.

Do I think people who have traffic infractions should pay a fine? Yes. But we're getting to the point where to register your car, to pay insurance, to put gas in the car, everything is getting so frightfully expensive. This is another \$50 surcharge on top of the surcharges that we already have, on top of the fines that we originally imposed. We're getting to the point of saturation, and we're absolutely killing the taxpayers.

This bill is replete with problems independent of some of the things that Senator LaValle mentioned regarding the police. It

therefore, some people could say that the performance of that fund has not been doing particularly well.

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This bill is also at the request of the Comptroller. And while it is seemingly intended to try to minimize the impact that localities may have on burgeoning pension contributions as a result of losses in the possession fund, it will further exacerbate additional losses to the fund due to the fact that the underlying assumptions as to how its -- the rate of payback for the loans that are basically in the billions of dollars that are being authorized now from the pension fund will now get rates of return to pay back those funds that are less than the assumptions of the amount of return that the pension fund was supposed to get in order to remain actuarially sound.

This is an extraordinarily reckless proposal. And to advance it at 1 o'clock in the morning, when it is going to authorize the largest borrowing in the history of the State of New York as against the pension system, in

my judgment is something that we should not be going into very, very quickly in this hour without a great deal of additional study and work.

I am fearful that this bill is reckless, it will cost the pension system even more money, it will cost municipalities more money in the end because it will further erode the value of that fund, which then they have to make up in the end.

So while it sounds like a nice little rollover of contributions in amortizing -- oh, it's got nice little terms and phrases in it -- the underlying assumptions and the amount of money that will be paid in the form of interest will be less than the amount of money that the pension fund was presumed to be able to earn in any particular time.

Mr. President, I urge that this bill be either withdrawn, laid aside, or certainly defeated at this time, because I don't think that we should be going into it in this fashion without a lot further

I joined you because I don't believe in taxes. I don't believe that the people of the State of New York have to keep being punished tax after tax after tax.

I'm asking you now, now I'm asking you to do the same here for the City of

New York. I joined you, I voted with you to kill some tax for you earlier to help your constituents. I crossed the aisle, I crossed my party to go with you to help you guys so you could stop taxes for your people.

Now I'm asking you now, join with me now. Join me now. Show me that you care. Show me that you are my friends. Show me that I can work with you when we need each other. I make a lot of enemies. See, I took a chance. I crossed my party, I went to you to help you people in Nassau County so you people don't get taxes.

So now the people of the City of

New York, the bodegueros, the taxi drivers, the senior citizens, the poor people of the City of New York are being burdened with taxes. MTA taxes, subway taxes, taxes on meals, cigarette taxes. There is not a single tax that the mayor of the City of New York doesn't like. Name it, and he tax, tax.

So I'm asking you again, join me so I could see that in the future I could jump too and join you when you really need me. I need you today. I challenge you, I'm challenging you today, join me. Let's stop the burden of the people of the State of New York. And I just proved to you that I could do it, that when I want I could jump. Proven to me that you could jump too.

And we could stop the taxes for the City of New York. We just stopped the taxes for Nassau County. Ladies and gentlemen, Liz Benjamin --

(Laughter.)

SENATOR DIAZ: -- we stopped taxes. Fifteen minutes after 1:00, I've got 50 more minutes.

Mr. Leader, I crossed you today, my leader -- two leaders -- today I just crossed my new majority leader to join you guys to show you that I care for the people of Nassau County. As you should care for the people of the City of New York.

So join me. Let's see if we could have a partnership. Let's see if in the future Reverend Diaz -- let's see if in the future Reverend Diaz could say, Senator Skelos, I'm going to join you today. Let's see. Let's see if in the future Senator Reverend Diaz could say: Senator Libous, I'm going to join you today, I'm going to cross lines and I'm going to join you today because I believe in what you're doing. Let's see if I could do that in the future. Because I did it tonight.

And I was no fool when I was doing that; I knew what I was doing. I knew what I was doing. I was throwing you a peace offering. Peace offering. And I did it, and my leader looked at me and said, "What are you doing?" I was helping the people of Nassau

County.

So now I'm asking that you help the people of the City of New York -- the bodegueros, the taxi drivers, the senior citizens, people that have been burdened with taxes. Taxes on taxis. Taxes on horse rides. Taxes on milk. Taxes on subways. Taxes on cigarettes. Taxes -- even the mayor wanted to put taxes on plastic bags, garbage, plastic bags. Taxes all over.

So this is one of them. This is one of the taxes. But you know, the mayor of the City of New York could -- to solve the problem, he could cease with so -- they have so many consultant contracts wasting millions and millions and millions of dollars in consultant contracts. They could do away with that. They don't have to impose taxes to the people.

When I was growing up in

Puerto Rico -- I got 40 more minutes. I got

40 more minutes. When I was growing up in

Puerto Rico, in Barrio Hato Tejas, Bayamon,

there was no taxes at that time. People used

to go to any palm tree or to the coconut tree or whatever you want to call it, and we used -- you know, there was no taxes, none of those things.

But now, in the City of New York, 67 years later, I see taxes to senior citizens, taxes to everybody.

So I don't want to -- I don't want to punish you anymore. I just -- look, is she sleeping? Don't sleep on me. Don't go to sleep on me now.

Just I'm asking you to help me prevent taxes for the people of the City of New York as I helped you prevent taxes for the people of Nassau County.

So, Senator Skelos, I never lie. I have always been truthful to you. I give you my hand, I keep my word. So I'm telling you right now, in front of all -- of everybody and in front of Liz Benjamin, I'm telling you now that if you help me, that if you help me tonight, help the people of the City of New York by not imposing taxes to them, in the future you will not regret it.

But like so many other bills we passed here tonight, this is a local tax bill requested by the City of New York with a home-rule message supported by their local legislature, the City Council, because they have a budget problem just like we have faced a budget problem.

And the analysis is they have a \$500 million hole in their budget if they can't increase their sales tax, and that they are losing \$60 million per month by our not moving this legislation.

So I won't disagree with Senator

Diaz that there could be ways that the City of

New York could in fact decrease some of their

costs. They could perhaps increase

efficiencies.

And yet we, as we know, have our own headaches here running our state government. I'm not sure we're up to taking on solving the problems of every local government or every county government in the state right now.

So I ask you to join with me in

supporting this bill, because the fundamental argument here, this is a local sales tax at the request of the City of New York, with the support of the local legislature, just like we could have gone down the list tonight and I could read many, many counties that we were moving tax bills for.

So of course no one ever wants to coat vote for an increase in taxes. No one usually wants to put their name on a tax bill. But I stand here tonight asking you to do this because my city, New York City, needs the revenue. I am being told that they have delayed hiring additional police, hiring additional emergency service workers because we have delayed so far in moving the sales tax.

So I hope, just like Senator Diaz has asked you to reach across the aisle and not vote for the bill, I'm asking you to join us in voting for the bill.

Thank you, Mr. President.

ACTING PRESIDENT VALESKY: Thank you, Senator Krueger.

Senator Monserrate, on the bill. 1 2 SENATOR MONSERRATE: Thank you 3 very much, Mr. Presiding Officer. 4 I also rise in opposition to this 5 bill, and I join my colleague Ruben Diaz. 6 When we speak about what this bill potentially can do, we're looking at a tax 7 8 increase that will bring us very close to 9 9 percent in sales tax. This is bad for small businesses -- bodegas, delis and small 10 shops -- this is bad for businesses in Lower 11 Manhattan and in Staten Island, where folks 12 can cross a bridge and go to New Jersey and 13 shop for their wares and their needs without 14 15 this tax. The reality is, ladies and 16 gentlemen, this is the worst of tax-and-spend 17 liberalism. And I know my colleagues on that 18 side of the aisle do not support that 19 20 fundamentally. 21 I know that several of my 22 colleagues here on June 30th sent a message to the administration of the City of New York and 23 24 said no to an increase in sales tax.

For those of us who are more progressive, a sales tax is amongst the most regressive taxation schemes. We should be against this. We should call on the mayor to be more fiscally prudent. He speaks boldly about being a businessman that makes billions of dollars, but he says he needs to increase taxes on middle-class New Yorkers and the working poor in our city.

So to the administration, I say:
You got it wrong. Go back to those books.
Make some cuts. Make some adjustments. Be
more progressive. Let's get rid of all these
consultant contracts for millions upon
millions of dollars. And let's have the
courage to vote no to this increase.

To my colleague Dan Squadron, who I promised I would be very short, because he's getting married soon -- Saturday, right? He's getting married Saturday. Hurry up and get married before we pass this bill --

(Laughter.)

As Senator Monserrate indicated, a sales tax is one of the most regressive things that you can do. What does regressive mean? It means that poor people as a percentage of their salaries -- of their income, actually -- pay more in sales taxes than rich people do. So the more money that you make, the less that this affects you.

So when you look at people in my community and many of the communities that we represent in New York City, our folks are going to be disproportionately affected in a negative way by the extension of this sales tax.

What is different about this sales tax as opposed to the 200 other sales taxes that we extended throughout this evening is that when you look at the amount of this sales tax, it is far greater than any of the other ones that we've passed tonight.

In addition, not passing this bill tonight helps New York City have a competitive

economic development advantage with

New Jersey, its neighbor who it completes
with.

As Senator Monserrate indicated, particularly in places like Staten Island, that is a simple bridge away from New Jersey, not enacting this sales tax will level the playing field and allow people to keep their dollars in New York City. That would help small businesses, that would help a lot of the little guy who we come here and we claim that we want to help.

And so I'm asking my colleagues tonight, as somebody who lives and works in New York City, to vote no on this bill. It is not a good bill for the small businesses. It's not a good bill for the people every day who are trying to make it, who work hard and who are already paying so many other taxes in this state. To have to pay this extended sales tax would be a really, really significant undue burden.

We have been asked by the current mayor of the City of New York to do this. And

why have we done this? He's asked us to do this, to come here and put another regressive tax on the table, because this is a man who simply taxes his way out of every single problem that he's gotten into.

When he got elected, the first thing he did was pass the most expansive property tax increase in the history of New York City. Right? And many of you know that, many of you lived through that. And they gave it back, and now they've in fact now reenacted that property tax.

And these taxes are never an answer to the problem. When we had a problem around traffic and we had a problem in the city around the environment, what was the answer? A congestion price tax. Then, when the MTA got into trouble, what did he want to do? He wanted to tax the bridges across the East River.

Enough is enough, Mr. Mayor.

Enough is enough. The people of the City of

New York can't take another tax from you. We
can't take, you know, another increase when

people are losing their jobs and people are trying to make it day to day. When people are just trying to put food in their mouths, we just can't simply tax and tax and tax and tax and tax and tax people.

And it's easy for him, because he's a billionaire. He's the richest person in the state, he's the 16th richest person in the entire country. And so for him, ah, another 8 percent here, another 9 percent here. He'll make that overnight, you know, on the stock exchange.

But most of us don't have, unfortunately, that kind of wealth. And so to continue to tax and tax regular everyday people is not what we ought to do.

This is also the same person, while he's proposing the highest property taxes in the history of New York City, a tax for congestion pricing, a tax for the MTA on the East River bridges, an increased sales tax, who stood up and wanted to protect rich people in Manhattan when he didn't want to do a Fair Share Tax to bring this state into balance.

We can't afford these policies,
ladies and gentlemen. We simply can't afford
to do it. The City of New York has the fourth
largest budget in the country. It's the
federal government's budget, it's the state of
California, it's the State of New York and the
City of New York.

The City of New York has a budget that if it was a Fortune 500 company, it would be in the top ten. It has a budget that is larger than 48 other states. As such, there is more than one way, Mr. President, for them to skin the cat.

So for people like myself and Liz Benjamin, \$500 million is a lot of money.

(Laughter.)

SENATOR PARKER: But for the City of New York, \$500 million is a significant sum but not all the money in the world. They can certainly find other ways to skin that cat.

And so I'm voting no today because

I need to stand up for the everyday people who

are working in our communities, who are trying

to make it day to day. And the taxes on milk

and on Pampers and on clothes and on 1 everything that we tax in New York City can't 2 3 simply go on this way. 4 We can't simply continue to, you 5 know, stand up for, you know, a billionaire mayor who thinks it's okay to tax regular 6 7 people but doesn't want to see, you know, the 8 rich people of the state pay their fair share. 9 It can no longer continue to go on that way. 10 And so I'm urging my colleagues to join me on the side of right, on the side of 11 12 fairness. I want them to join me and my colleagues who are voting no on this bill 13 because it is the right thing to do. 14 15 I vote no.
