Specialist Dikcis was killed in Afghanistan while serving his country.

I spoke yesterday to his dad and to his brother. And clearly, we have seen all too often in this chamber, we have memorialized the service and sacrifice of young men and women like Alan Dikcis -- good soldiers, good Americans, great citizens of New York who have gone, when their country has called, over to places of war representing this great country and this great state.

Mr. President, I ask all my 1 2 colleagues to join me in this resolution 3 memorializing this very special New Yorker, 4 this very special son, this very special 5 brother, Alan Dikcis.
