2 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON: The
3 Senate will please come to order.

4 I ask everyone present to rise and
5 recite with me the Pledge of Allegiance to our
6 Flag.

7 (Whereupon, the assemblage recited
8 the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.)

9 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON: In the
10 absence of clergy, may we all bow our heads in
11 a moment of silence.

12 (Whereupon, the assemblage
13 respected a moment of silence.)

14 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON: The
15 reading of the Journal.

16 The Secretary will read.

17 THE SECRETARY: In Senate,
18 Wednesday, March 24, the Senate met pursuant
19 to adjournment. The Journal of Tuesday,
20 March 23, was read and approved. On motion,
21 Senate adjourned.

22 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON:

9 SENATOR KLEIN: Thank you,
10 Mr. President.

11 On behalf of Senator Smith, I move
12 that the following bills be discharged from
13 their respective committees and be recommitted
14 with instructions to strike the enacting
15 clause: Senate Number 7088.

16 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON: So
17 ordered.

18 Senator Klein.

19 SENATOR KLEIN: On behalf of
20 Senator Espada, I move to amend Senate Bill
21 Number 6168A by striking out the amendments
22 made on March 10th and restoring it to its
23 original print number, 6168.

24 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON: So
25 ordered.

1 Senator Klein.

2 SENATOR KLEIN: Mr. President, on
3 behalf of Senator Stachowski, I move that the
4 following bill be discharged from its
5 respective committee and be recommitted with
6 instructions to strike the enacting clause:
7 Senate Number 1946.

8 ACTING PRESIDENT JOHNSON: So
9 ordered.

11 SENATOR KLEIN: Mr. President,
12 can we please move to a reading of the
13 calendar.
