PROCEEDINGS 1 2 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: The 3 Senate will come to order. 4 I ask everyone present to please 5 rise and repeat with me the Pledge of Allegiance. 6 7 (Whereupon, the assemblage recited 8 the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.) 9 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: We are 10 joined today by Reverend Dennis Campbell, of United Community Baptist Church in Brooklyn. 11 12 Reverend. 13 REVEREND CAMPBELL: I am honored 14 and delighted to be here and to be asked to give 15 the invocation. 16 I just want to say thanks to Senator Kevin Parker of the 21st District, where 17 18 United Community Baptist Church is located. 19 It is in this spirit that I greet 20 all who are here today. Let us pray. 21 Almighty and Ever-Living God, in whom we live and move and have our being, we bow 22 23 humbly before You this morning. We give You thanks, O Lord, for Your goodness at all times 24 25 and in all places.

Open our eyes that we may behold 1 2 Your Fatherly presence about us. Draw our 3 hearts unto You with the power of Your love. 4 Teach us, O God our Father, to be anxious for 5 nothing. And when we have done all that 6 7 You've asked us to do, help us to leave the issue to Your infinite wisdom. We acknowledge 8 that You are the only one who can rightly lead 9 10 and guide Your people. 11 We pray, Holy Father, for Your 12 blessings upon these assembled in this chamber, especially for the men and women who have been 13 14 given the awesome responsibility to conduct the 15 affairs of this great state. Grant them wisdom and strength that they may serve always with 16 dignity, conviction, and humility. 17 18 When in the execution of their 19 duties they encounter difficult and challenging 20 situations, help them, we pray, to hold onto their sense of perspective. 21 Guide them, O Lord, we beseech You, 22 with the power of Your spirit, and sustain them 23 with the strength of Your divine grace, that 24 25 they may overcome every obstacle that stands in

1 the way of progress and remain steadfast in 2 their commitment to uphold the principles of 3 truth, justice, and liberty. 4 Give them clarity of mind, strength 5 of purpose, and firmness of will as they seek to carry out their individual and collective 6 7 responsibilities. Help them in their deliberation to be courteous and generous, brave 8 and able, dutiful and faithful. 9 10 And, O Lord, may Your presence be with them, may Your spirit guide them, and may 11 12 Your grace sustain them now and always. 1 Messages from the Governor. 2 Reports of standing committees. 3 Reports of select committees. 4 Communications and reports from state officers. 5 Motions and resolutions. б 7 Senator Libous. 8 SENATOR LIBOUS: Thank you, 9 Mr. President. 10 At this time may we please adopt the Resolution Calendar. 11 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: All in 12 favor of adopting the Resolution Calendar signify 13 by saying aye. 14 15 (Response of "Aye.") 16 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Opposed, 17 nay. 18 (No response.) ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: 19 The 20 Resolution Calendar is adopted. 21 Senator Libous. 22 SENATOR LIBOUS: Thank you, Mr. President. 23 At this time could we have the 24 25 reading of the noncontroversial calendar, please.

1 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: The 2 Secretary will read. 3 THE SECRETARY: Calendar Number 49, by Senator Fuschillo, Senate Print 773, an act to 4 5 amend the Public Health Law. ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Read the 6 7 last section. 8 THE SECRETARY: Section 2. This 9 act shall take effect immediately. 10 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Call the roll. 11 12 (The Secretary called the roll.) 13 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Announce the results. 14 15 THE SECRETARY: In relation to 16 Calendar Number 49, those recorded in the negative are Senators Avella, Espaillat, 17 18 Gianaris, Hoylman, Krueger, Montgomery, Peralta, 19 Perkins, Rivera, Sampson, Sanders, Serrano, 20 Squadron and Stavisky. 21 Ayes, 46. Nays, 14. 22 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: The bill 23 is passed. THE SECRETARY: Calendar Number 52, 24 25 by Senator Golden --

1 SENATOR LIBOUS: Lay that bill 2 aside for the day, please. ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: The bill 3 4 is laid aside for the day. 5 THE SECRETARY: Calendar Number 194, by Senator Golden, Senate Print 2098, an act 6 7 to amend the Penal Law. 8 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Read the 9 last section. 10 THE SECRETARY: Section 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November. 11 12 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Call the roll. 13 (The Secretary called the roll.) 14 15 THE SECRETARY: Ayes, 60. 16 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: The bill is passed. 17 18 That completes the noncontroversial reading of the calendar. 19 20 Senator Libous. SENATOR LIBOUS: 21 Thank you, Mr. President. 22 Mr. President, we have a hand-up. 23 In consultation with Senator Skelos and 24 25 Senator Klein, Senator Stewart-Cousins hands up

the following information to the desk, please. 1 2 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Please 3 file what you received in the Journal. 4 Is there any further business at the 5 desk? б (Laughter.) 7 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Senator 8 Libous. 9 SENATOR LIBOUS: Thank you, 10 Mr. President. Before I ask if there's any other 11 business at the desk, I would ask, Mr. President, 12 that you call on Senator Gianaris for the 13 14 purposes of an announcement. 15 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Senator 16 DeGianaris. 17 (Laughter.) 18 SENATOR GIANARIS: Thank you, Mr. President --19 20 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: I always 21 make you a DeGianaris, don't I? I meant to say Senator Gianaris. 22 SENATOR GIANARIS: Senator DeGriffo 23 reminds me of that every so often. 24 25 (Laughter.)

1 SENATOR GIANARIS: Mr. President, I 2 in turn will ask you to please call on Senator Serrano for a conference announcement. 3 4 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: Senator 5 Serrano. SENATOR SERRANO: There will be an 6 7 immediate meeting of the Senate Democratic 8 Conference in Room 315. 9 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: 10 Immediate meeting of the Senate Democratic Conference in Room 315. 11 Senator Libous. 12 SENATOR LIBOUS: Mr. President, is 13 14 there any further business at the desk? 15 ACTING PRESIDENT BONACIC: There is no further business, Senator Libous. 16 SENATOR LIBOUS: 17 Thank you, 18 Mr. President. 19 I would remind the Republican 20 Conference members that they will have conference at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, which will be the 23rd 21 22 of March. 23 And there being no further business, I move that we adjourn until Saturday, 24 25 March 23rd, at 4:00 p.m., intervening days being
