Last week in our biblical reading we read a story in the Book of Numbers of a man named Korach, who challenged Moses for the leadership of the Israelites. And Korach sought a position of leadership not out of a desire to serve, but out of a desire to rule for his own sense of power and wanting glory and dominion over others.

And this kind of leadership causes division, strife and, in the story we read in the Book of Numbers, even death.

There is a resolution at the end of the story when Moses affirms to his brother

Aaron, the high priest of the Israelites, that leadership does not mean only power and glory for the leader, but rather leadership means service, bearing in mind the entire people and their needs, bearing in mind that you serve a greater community and a greater good -- a kind of leadership that is now called servant leadership, which is, in its root, biblical leadership.

And this is the kind of leadership

that I pray to the source of my strength that all of us in this chamber are blessed to accomplish. This is true leadership: Service, humility, bound together with others through the values we all share. Values like healing, hope, justice, mercy, fairness, equality, dignity and generosity.

We believe many things in this wonderfully diverse State of New York. We have many faiths, and some of us have no particular religious faith, but we are bound together in a commitment to serve.

And so I turn to the one I call
God, the source of my strength, the source of my
wisdom, who you may know through a different
name or through a different experience. But I
hope you will turn to that source of meaning in
your life and find that core of values that can
bind you to others and the common work of
leadership for our great state -- the values
that bind us together as a citizenry, and the
values that will bring our state and our common
mission together into a great future together.

I thank God for the strength that we may all accomplish this, and I thank you for
