2 THE PRESIDENT: The Senate will  
3 come to order.

4 I ask everyone present to please  
5 rise and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

6 (Whereupon, the assemblage recited  
7 the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.)

8 THE PRESIDENT: In the absence of  
9 clergy, let us bow our heads in a moment of  
10 silent reflection or prayer.

11 (Whereupon, the assemblage respected  
12 a moment of silence.)

13 THE PRESIDENT: Let me just start,  
14 if I may, and just say it's an honor to be here  
15 as Lieutenant Governor to preside over this  
16 extraordinary session to tackle this very, very  
17 serious issue.

18 I know that you've all been hard at  
19 work throughout the day yesterday and this  
20 morning. Extraordinary times call for  
21 extraordinary sessions like these. And it is  
22 incumbent upon all of us to show up and do the  
23 work. So I want to just thank each and every one  
24 of you for your time and for your commitment.

1                   SENATOR KENNEDY:    Thank you,  
2   Mr. President.

3                   Welcome, and congratulations.  It is  
4   wonderful to have you here before us in this  
5   great chamber here today as we do the people's  
6   business.

7                   Please read the proclamation of the  
8   Governor that's at the desk.

9                   THE PRESIDENT:    There is a  
10   proclamation from the Governor at the desk.

11                   The Secretary will read.

12                   THE SECRETARY:    "Pursuant to the  
13   power vested in me by Article IV, Section 3, of  
14   the Constitution, I hereby convene the Senate and  
15   Assembly of the State of New York in  
16   Extraordinary Session, at the Capitol, in the  
17   City of Albany, on the 30th day of June, 2022, at  
18   12 o'clock p.m. for the purpose of:

19                   "Considering legislation I will  
20   submit with respect to addressing necessary  
21   statutory changes regarding firearm safety, in a  
22   way that ensures protection of public safety and  
23   health, after the United States Supreme Court  
24   decision in New York State Rifle and Pistol  
25   Association, Inc. v. Bruen.

1                   "Given under my hand and the Privy  
2   Seal of the State in the City of Albany this  
3   24th day of June in the year 2022.

4                   "By Governor Kathy Hochul."

7                   SENATOR KENNEDY:   I now hand up the  
8                   following resolution and ask for its immediate  
9                   adoption.

10                  THE PRESIDENT:   The Secretary will  
11                  read.

12                  THE SECRETARY:   Senate Resolution  
13                  1, by Senator Stewart-Cousins, providing for the  
14                  introduction of bills in the Senate during the  
15                  Extraordinary Session.

16                  THE PRESIDENT:   The question is on  
17                  the resolution.

18                  All in favor signify by saying aye.

19                  (Response of "Aye.")

20                  THE PRESIDENT:   Opposed?

21                  (Response of "Nay.")

22                  THE PRESIDENT:   The resolution is  
23                  adopted.

24                  Senator Kennedy.

25                  SENATOR KENNEDY:   Mr. President,

1 the Senate will stand at ease.

2 THE PRESIDENT: The Senate will  
3 stand at ease.

4 (Whereupon, the Senate stood at ease  
5 at 12:54 p.m.)
